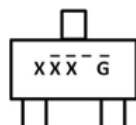

This is part of the alignment and marking standardization.

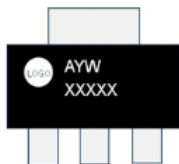
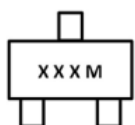
For a specific OPN that is build in different sites will now have the same lay out scheme and will just differ on the plant code.
